November Indulgences for the Holy Souls

- Have confessed (at any time within the week preceding or following 1st November)
- Received Holy Communion (any day from 1st – 8th November)
- Prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father, and Hail Mary or any other prayer of one's choice)

Book of Remembrance
 During the month of November, we are asked to pray for the dead. With this in mind you will see a Book of Remembrance on a table at the front of the Church (near the pulpit). You are invited to place the names of your loved ones in the book and they will be prayed for during the month of November.
