# THE ADVENT WREATH

The ADVENT WREATH is made from evergreen leaves that are woven around a circle of wire. It has FOUR CANDLES (3 purple AND 1 rose coloured). It is decorated with a PURPLE ribbon.



The circle of EVERGREEN LEAVES represents GOD who IS without beginning or end.

The PURPLE RIBBON and PURPLE CANDLES represent our need to grow and change from selfishness and sin.

The ROSE CANDLE is a sign of the joy that comes from living in God's way of love. (We will light the ROSE candle on the 3rd Sunday of Advent).

Circle me, Lord.

Keep protection near; keep danger afar.

Keep hope within; keep doubt without.

Circle me, Lord.

Keep light near; keep darkness afar.
