A Message from Fr. Peter O'Connor

SYNOD

Thank you for your response to the synod box in the church. There have been over 30 responses in the box and via email.

I suggested that I would give a half-way report on some of the emerging themes:

1. The Church is a valued place for prayer and worship

2. Due to the pandemic and restrictions people are feeling a loss of Church community and have missed meeting others

3. There is a strong feeling of anger, hurt and betrayal towards the institution of the Church due to past and on-ging scandals

4. There is a great concern about the lack of vocations with an over whelming number of questions about the role of women in all areas of the Church and the role of married men and priests who have left active ministry

Thank you for your replies. If you wish to take part in the process, please fill in the form – these are located on a table in front of the Statue of The Sacred Heart. The process moves forward to a Diocesan-wide Consultation in May, and then a national consultation later in the year.
