### **FINANCE REPORT 2021**

### **PARISH FUNDS**

- Firstly, thank you all so much for your continued contributions to the Parish Support Fund.
- Thank you also for stopping by our Church to light candles at our shrines, even while public Masses remained unavailable in 2021.
- Income for 2021, as in 2020, remained below pre-COVID levels.
- Our Expenses decreased slightly in 2021 due to lower levels of activity brought about by the COVID restrictions, including the deferring of some maintenance work on our buildings.
- The Parish continues to run an annual deficit of expenses over regular income. This would be of real concern were it not for once-off donations / bequests received; however, these cannot be guaranteed in any given year.
- The Presbytery at 23 Barclay Court was sold during 2021, realising a Gain on Sale of just over €600,000.

### **DIOCESAN COLLECTIONS**

- The First and Second Collections at Sunday Mass have recovered well as public Masses slowly returned after COVID. However, these still remain below pre-COVID levels.
- Christmas, Easter and Summer Dues have been very well supported, and, as all Dues, along with the First Collection, are used to maintain the priests of the Diocese including our own, we are most grateful.

### **PROJECTS**

The **Living the Joy of the Gospel** initiative which many of you so generously supported has come to an end. Over the course of six years it enabled the following projects to be completed:

- access ramp, automated doors and shortening of the pews in St Anne's Aisle for improved accessibility
- new electronic organ and parish hymn books
- · re-surfacing of the grounds between the Church and Parish Centre
- the new parish website www.sib.ie
- repairs to the kneelers
- public access to toilet facilities in the Church building

Other projects undertaken recently include:

- installing Wi-Fi in the Church
- replacement of the old boiler
- replacing the old linoleum flooring in the Parish Centre
- repairing and painting the cast iron gutters and down-pipes on the Church
