

#### **HOME AND AWAY**

This weekend near the front of the Church a map of the world will be displayed. Beside the map there will be some stick-on arrows with room on each arrow for a name of a person or family. This is an opportunity for people to remember their loved ones who live far away outside of Ireland. Many parishioners have loved ones whom they left behind to come to Ireland or have relations who have emigrated or live abroad. Pray Away Week is an opportunity to pray together and remember those who live far away, but are very close to our hearts.
