THE ADVENT WREATH

The ADVENT WREATH is made from **evergreen leaves** that are woven around a circle of wire. It has FOUR CANDLES (**3 purple** AND **1 rose** coloured). It is decorated with a PURPLE ribbon.



The circle of **EVERGREEN LEAVES** represents GOD who IS without beginning or end.

The **PURPLE RIBBON** and **PURPLE CANDLES** represent our need to grow and change from selfishness and sin.

The ROSE CANDLE is a sign of the joy that comes from living in God's way of love. (We will light the ROSE candle on the 3rd Sunday of Advent).
