### **Dear Parishioners,**

The statues of St. Anne and St. Patrick have recently been re painted. The statue of St. Anne and Our Lady as a little girl is on display, in preparation for the feast days of the parents of our lady and the grandparents of Jesus which takes place next weekend.

I am also pleased to inform you that the problems with the webcam have been addressed and hopefully resolved!

During the past few weeks repairs have taken place to the porch roof which flooded during the downpour in mid-June. There will be more repairs needed to the Church roof during the next year.

In consultation with the Parish Finance Committee and from feedback through the Parish Pastoral Council after meeting with parish volunteers we aim to:

- Place QR codes on the parish newsletter for the collections and the contributions to parish maintenance.
- We hope to have a general clean of the Church, especially cleaning of some of the higher ledges and radiators in the Church during the summer months.

If any parishioner wishes to contribute to the cost of the statues or repairs a contribution would be greatly appreciated.

The re-painting of the statues and transportation cost €1,100.00.

The webcam services costs €184 a month.

The initial repairs to the Church porch and lost roof tiles this June amounted to €17,000.00, and there is also some additional work to be completed to the roof.

A survey has been completed assessing damage to some of the stained-glass windows which has a costing of €8,000-00.

I thank you for your support and we pray for and remember grandparents as we approach the celebrations next weekend for Sts. Joachim and Anne.
